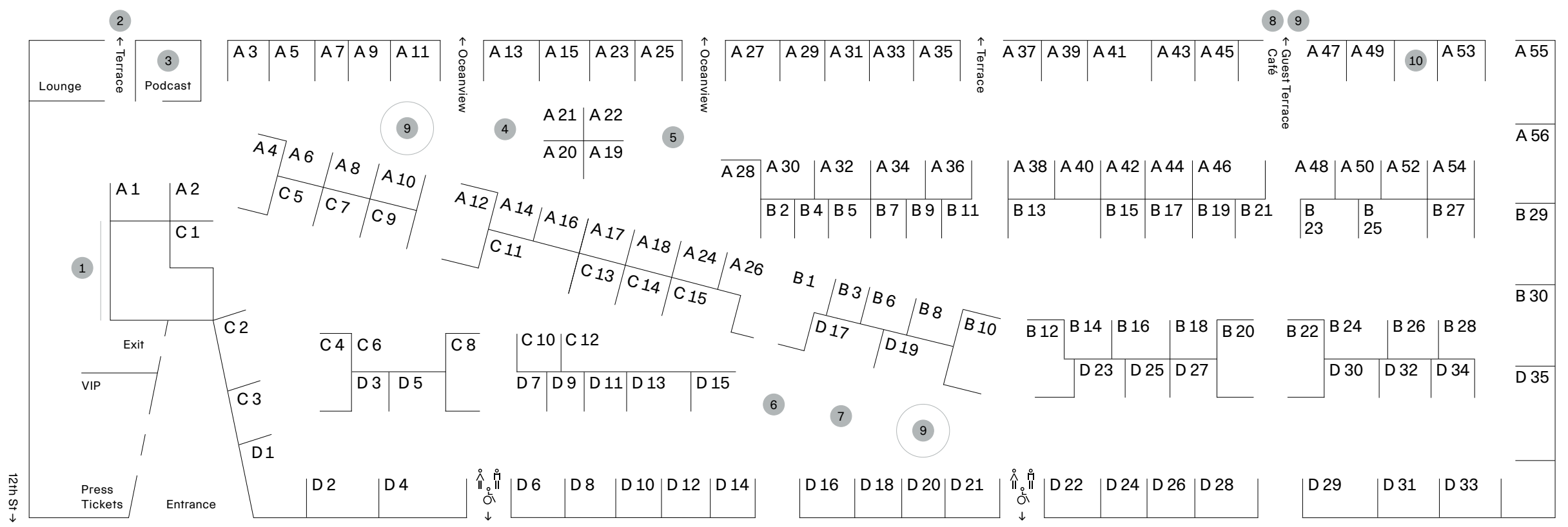

Joya is a New York City-based scent design studio founded by Frederick Bouchardy in 2006. For over 10 years, the world's best designers and brands have come to Joya to create signature scents for skin and air. The company collaborates across a myriad of creative disciplines to form a singular vision with a shared spirit. These works reward the passion for discovery with fascinating challenges and exquisite delights. Joya's first scent for Untitled Art, called *021*, is an invisible piece of art that twists one of Florida's most important symbols – the orange plant – with both traditional elements of fig leaf and rosewater and modern, sheer notes of amber and aloe. The result is evocative yet unplaceable.
